This month our meeting will be on Monday, June 21st. Elections will be held at this meeting. Don't let this frighten you away; we'd love to have your input.

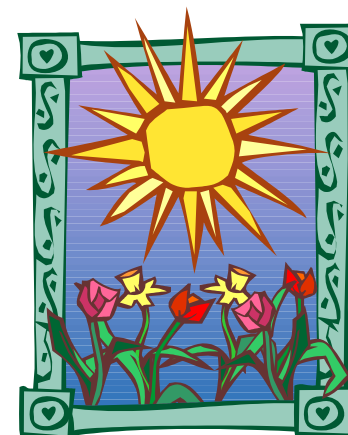
LIBRARY CORNER
